
Report of Activities from July 2022 to June 2023




3. Winners Got Prize for Naalam


7. Cleantech Challenge (Introductory Event)


8. Anti-Drug Pledge




9. Paper Pen Making Competition

14. Jeevana Coupon Release


Date: 31.07.2022 Venue: Viswajyothi College of Engineering and Technology


15. Distributing Coupon For Jeevana


21. Collection of Funds for Jeevana




22. Clean Up Drive -Tourism Day


29. Session on Basic Life Support and CPR






36. NRPF Orientation Program





37. LED Manufacturing Workshop


41. Republic Day Celebration and Cleaning




49. **Dhruva 2023 Day - 1**







Date: 14.03.2023 Venue: Government Medical College, Idukki





A special meeting was convened afterward, where participants shared their cherished memories and valuable experiences from their time at the camp. In a heart-warming


ceremony, awards were presented to recognize the best male and female campers as well as the best team.


59. International Yoga Day
