

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

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




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1) Webinar on "Overseas Exposure, opportunities and cultural Integration- Singapore Context" Conducted on July 4th 2020


Program Outcomes







This Online Training was truly informative for the students. It helped a lot to know about LaTeXand Overleaf along with the benefits as well as the downsides of document creation using LaTeX.


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


Conclusion



Program Outcomes


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
This webinar was quite explanatory and informative for the students in choosing their field of career. From this training session the students were able to build and assess data models and to execute statistical analyses with statistical software.


Program outcomes





Program Outcome


The webinar has given clear guidelines on how to frame a startup policy. The speaker also shared his ideas of enhancing the entrepreneurial skills and abilities in students

Program Outcomes




