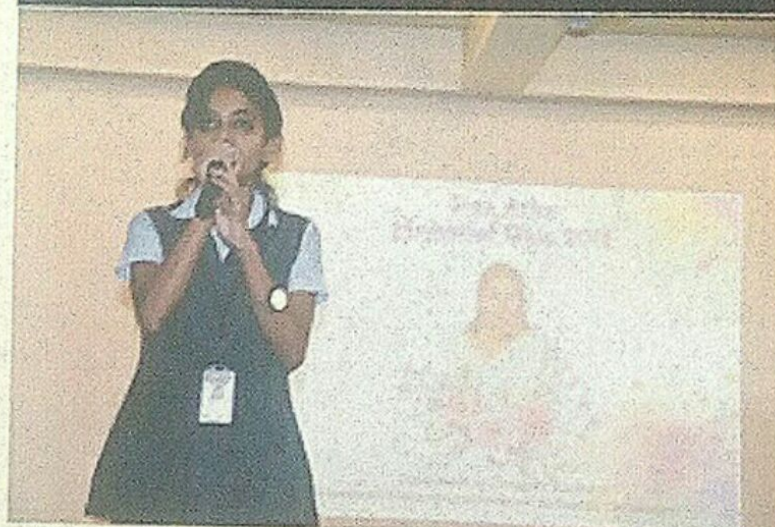
Even after my four years of college life, the Civil Department and VJCET family teaching me, helping and giving confidence to me in my career challenges.
