
2. ENVIRONMENT DAY




4. NATIONAL OLYMPICS DAY TALK

5. NATIONAL OLYMPICS DAY ENDURANCE RUN COMPETITION




8. GROUND CULTIVATION

10. BLOOD DONATION CAMB STAGE-2



13. NEW RUDHIRASENA COORDINATORS REGISTRATION



16. ANTI-DRUG PLEDGE






23. DISTRIBUTING COUPON FOR JEEVANA






24. HAR GHAR TIRANGA DAY 1








27. HAR GHAR TIRANGA CERTIFICATION

41. ONE CAMPUS ONE IAS QUIZ











44. LED MANUFACTURING WORKSHOP


