4.3.5 NATURE CONSERVATION DAY


- On July 28th 2022, as a part of Nature Conservation Day, NSS volunteers conducted maintenance and cleaning tasks in the vegetable garden.

4.3.9 HAR GHAR TIRANGA DAY 3


- The third day of Har Ghar Tiranga was celebrated as part of the 75th Independence Day on 15th august 2022.





- Volunteers were responsible for planting and taking care of the saplings.







- The session familiarised the activities and agendas of energy cell..






Energy Cell Orientation


- Faculties published 14 research papers in the Journals notified on UGC website during the year.
