


### I. SEMINARS AND WORKSHOPS

Technical talks and workshops by expert from Industries are arranged in different departments for the benefit of students. Students got opportunities to interact with industrialist and clear many of the practical doubts.


### 1. Design Webinar


#### 2. Webinar

Screenshot of Webinar for Civil Engineering students




