

He has more than 140 publications in national and international journals. Dr. K.K. Rajan was Independent Director on the Board of Nuclear Power corporation of India Ltd, Government of India and served as the Chairman of the Project Design and Safety committee of Sodium Cooled Fast Breeder Reactor based Nuclear Power Projects of the country from April, 2023 and is actively involved in the safety review of PFBR which is in the advanced stage of commissioning at Kalpakkam. As Dean, Industry Institute interaction and Professor Electrical and Electronics Engineering Department at VJCET since 2016, he has successfully completed the research project, Development of level sensor for lead lithium alloy system, a BRNS funded project. He was appointed as Principal of VJCET from June 2020. He had played a key role in the NBA accreditation and NAAC accreditation of the college with A grade. Under his able leadership VJCET has driven excellence in the academic performance of the College to the present level of 13th the position among all the Engineering colleges under KTU.

Program Outcomes

Admission Procedure

Admission will be purely based on merit.

A rank list will be made from the aggregate score of a National Level Admission Test, Group Discussion and Personal Interview conducted with weightage of 80:10:10 respectively.

Intake capacity 60

Eligibility Criteria

Candidates who have been awarded or qualified for the award of Bachelor's Degree in Engineering / Technology / Business Administration with 50% marks in aggregate or Bachelor's Degree in Arts / Science / Commerce with 50% marks in aggregate for the main course papers are eligible to apply for admission to the MBA programme.

It is mandatory that students seeking admission to the MBA programme should have a valid score in a national level admission test, notified by the University or Government of Kerala. The valid National Level Tests are CAT, CMAT and KMAT Kerala with 15% as the cut off mark.

Reservation policy of the Government of Kerala and the Government of India shall be followed in admissions to the MBA programme.

The Gateway to a varied world

The core and crux of management education is the all-round development of the individual. VSMS through its multi-faceted training programmes, skill development initiatives and value-oriented instruction strives to transform the students into self- reliant, confident and mature individuals with clear career goals and heightened vision in life. The training here is meant to help the students to identify their hidden positive strengths and encourage them to plunge into the uncharted seas of opportunities and possibilities; finally giving them a strong foothold in the management and business landscape. Above everything else, they are made to formulate a wider vision of life, so as to make each one asks himself what can I do with what I have got?".

Course Duration

Duration of the MBA programme will normally be two academic years spanning four semesters. Each semester shall have 14 weeks of instruction with 29 hours per week. Continuous internal evaluation during the course period as well as University Examination at the end of each semester shall be conducted

Fee Structure

Admission will be Complete only on meeting all the requirements mentioned in the letter of admission and on payment of the fees. Failing to comply with this will lead to cancellation of admission. Application are accepted through Online.

At the end of the semester, semester examination will be conducted for all courses offered in the semester and will be of three-hour duration, unless otherwise specified. Supplementary examinations are to be conducted before the commencement of the next semester, for eligible Candidates registered for them.

Academic Assessment/Evaluation

The university follows a continuous academic evaluation procedure. Assessment procedure and the corresponding weights are as follows: -

About Placement Cell

Placement is a very important activity at Viswajyothi College of Engineering and Technology (VJCET). It has an independent placement cell focused to cater to the needs of leading organizations in conducting campus interviews for the final year students. The placement officer is assisted by student representatives. The committee evolves a broad policy framework every year. Students are closely co-opted in implementing these policy decisions.

The cell keeps close liaison with various industrial establishments (both private and public sectors), which conduct Campus interviews and select the student from all disciplines. Most of them visit the campus for holding Campus interviews. Viswajyothi School of Management (VSMS) has a dedicated placement cell which coordinates the placement activities synchronizing with the placement department of the college

Training & Development

Our department conducts various extra-curricular activities for the students to enhance their learning experience and to be in line with the current business happenings. Few of them are:


- Business Quiz
- Industry Familiarizations sessions by students
- Confidence Training Sessions

The Business Quiz happens weekly once which is mainly conducted by the students based on the news from the Business Line of the respective week. The students are divided into various groups that compete each other. The winning groups are awarded with prizes. Each group is coordinated and guided by a faculty.

The Industry Familiarization Sessions are taken by students based on their own choice of an industry. Presentations are conducted by group of students detailing about the chosen industry. A jury of faculty members will be present for the session and suggestions are provided to the students.

Confidence Training Sessions by a group of experts are conducted for the students of the MBA batch in order to give them training on Aptitude tests including Quantitative, Logical and Verbal based training. The sessions happen weekly once followed by online exams.

INFRASTRUCTURE

Building Area

The building complex of the college with an area of over 5 lakh sq. ft, is situated in a sprawling Campus of 26 acres. The building is divided into blocks A, B, C, D, Laboratory Block, Gents Hostel, Ladies Hostel and Auditorium Annexure. All academic and non-academic departments are included in the A, B, C and D blocks. A separate laboratory block is provided in addition to the academic blocks. Civil, Electrical and Mechanical workshops are in this block



Common Computing Centre

Viswajyothi has a central computing facility named as Common Computing Centre (CCC) functioning with a speed of 40 Mbps from 8 am to 8 pm. Students Can access Internet and download relevant study materials and can procure hard copies of the study materials with the assistance of staff at any time. The CCC is centrally air conditioned and well-equipped with an uninterrupted power supply

The Central Library

The Central Library of the College was established in the year 2001. It is housed in an area of 16400 sq. ft. spread over two floors. In addition, there are separate libraries in each department. It is fully automated with a rich collection of Books, National and International Journals, Technical and other Magazines, CD ROMs on Engineering, other widely appreciated editions on diverse subjects like Literature, Management, Religion etc. This library follows open access system, Bar code-based circulation process and OPAC Literature Search. Viswajyothi School of Management Studies is having an exclusive library for enhanced learning



Digital Library

This fully automated library is home to more than 4500 titles and about a quarter of a lakh of books & journals. The electronic division of the library is equipped with hundreds of e-journals including world renowned journals like JGate Management, IEEE, ASME, ASCE, ASTF, Springer, Elsevier, Ebscoetc.

Fitness

Viswajyothi has a multi gym with all most modern equipment. Students and members of faculty use this facility to keep their health in good Condition. They Can utilize the Gym facility in the early morning and evening hours.

Sports

At Viswajyothi, high classfacilities are provided for Sports & Games. Every year, annual sports is conducted in the college. Here, equal importance is being given to both academic and sports activities. Viswajyothi has a well-trained professional basketball team. Every year, Viswajyothi conducts an All Kerala Basket Ball Tournament, MAGNUM in the mid of February. A multipurpose stadium with 200 metre tracks, as well as a Football and Cricket ground are also maintained here. Many football & cricket tournaments are held here. The college has 9 badminton courts (4 indoor and 5 outdoor) where students and staffs practice on a daily basis
